#### **Autism Satellite Sites Training Information**

**What:** Autism Satellite Sites Training is a project created to provide 2.5-hour professional development sessions in the fall of 2018 at various "satellite sites" throughout Region 4. The sites were selected by grouping interested districts according to location and then obtaining participation from host districts. In all, four satellite sites were created. The fall 2018 training will address *Function-Based Interventions that Span the Autism Spectrum* (see the section, *Autism Satellite Sites Training Session Description*, below for additional session information). The table, *Autism Satellite Sites Dates, Locations, and Session IDs*, below provides information on district groupings, dates, times, session ID numbers, and locations.

**Why:** In reviewing attendance at the professional development sessions offered at Region 4, it was very clear that as the distance from the service center increased, district participation decreased. This project was created to address this trend and provide autism-related training to the districts that lie in the outer areas of our region with the hope that no participant would be required to travel more than 30 miles to attend.

**Who:** Any district personnel who support students with autism can attend these sessions; however, the sessions are designed for those who directly and regularly instruct students with autism in the classroom (e.g., teachers, paraprofessionals, SLPs, etc.).

**When:** Training dates for each district group is provided in the table, *Autism Satellite Sites Dates, Locations, and Session IDs*, below.

Where: Host districts are identified, and training location addresses are provided in the table, *Autism Satellite Sites Dates, Locations, and Session IDs*, below. **\*\*\*PLEASE NOTE: The addresses in the table below** *might* differ from the addresses given on the Region 4 web site registration pages. The trainings will take place at the addresses listed in the table below.\*\*\*

**How:** Session IDs are provided in the table, *Autism Satellite Sites Dates, Locations, and Session IDs*, below. Those who wish to participate will enroll by entering the Session ID number in the "Search PD" window on the home page of the Region 4 web site, <u>www.esc4.net</u>, and completing the registration process as they would for any other Region 4 professional development session. There is no charge for these sessions. We are offering 2 sessions on each training day – an AM session and a PM session – in order to better accommodate participants' schedules. The PM session is a repeat of the AM session.
